
Missionary to Honduras

Dear Pastors and praying friends,

It is hard to believe how fast time is flying by here in 2024. I apologize for not sending an update before now, but am very excited to tell you what the Lord is doing here at Hope Baptist Church in Santa Rita, Yoro, Honduras. Here are some of the things that have happened thus far in 2024.

## Looking back

The first week of January our teens went to camp. They had prepared for months prior for the competitions, and had done several fund raisers to



them take the next steps in their walk with the Lord, from Salvation to Baptism to discipleship classes, to asking where they can serve in the church. We praise the Lord for our teens and pray daily for them to be able to stand strong.

In March we began another English class. These classes are offered to the community and we saw many from outside the church come to take the classes. We just finished the 2nd of 3 levels and are enjoying our time with our students. We

treat this as not only a way to provide a service to the community. but also a Gospel outreach. Each lesson has a devotional time, sharing truths with them from the Bible, and they have learned to sing 2 songs in English, "Everybody Ought to Know", and "I Have Decided to Follow Jesus". The last session will end in July and there have already been questions about when the next class will



begin. Please help us pray for this amazing opportunity we have to share the Gospel with those who might not hear it if not for these classes.

## Looking forward

The next few months are shaping up to be busy times. We will be celebrating Mother's Day on the 12th of May. On the 19th - 22nd we will be having our Mission Conference, and hosting a group visiting from the States. In June we will have our 2nd Kindergarten graduation on the 6th and then an MMO medical group of over 60 people will be arriving on the 7th and we will have a medical brigade the following week. In August, when we begin the new school year, we have 2 new teachers who have signed on to help us out. We need 1 more teacher and would appreciate your prayers that the Lord will help us find the perfect person to teach our students.

Thanks to each of you for your prayers and support. I would love for you to be able to see first-hand all that the Lord is doing here because of your faithfulness.
