Let me back up and tell you of the blessings in April and May. The Easter outreach in the public schools and nursing homes went very well. Around 2,500 students and older people heard the resurrection story. Several people in the nursing homes prayed to receive Christ. In both Mountaintop Baptist Church and the new Neipu Baptist Church, we had a special meal with many new visitors coming.

In May we did something new for us. We went to several schools and nursing homes with a Mother's Day program. Also for Mothers' Day services, we had between the 2 churches 42 mothers who attended. Several were first time visitors. One mother has been saved since coming on Mother's Day. Another mother who was saved in a Bible study also came to church on Mother's Day for the first time. A worker in the nursing home has also been saved as a result of the Mother's Day program there.

We also had the privilege of leading a man to Christ through hospital visitation. He has visited the church since being released from the hospital. A high school student who grew up in China came to a youth meeting in May. It was the first time he had been to a church. Later in June, after a Sunday morning service, he accepted Christ.
