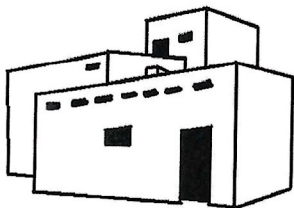

March—June 2024

Hello from Nuevo México. I apologize in advance for the lateness of this letter. It seems like the past four months have just blinked by. Thank you for praying for us. The Lord has been so good to us.

The work in Bernalillo is still moving forward. Sometimes it seems like we're stuck in granny-gear, but we continue to press toward the mark. The Lord has given us a huge visión for the future. Sometimes it is tempting to stagger at what God has planned, but we know that He is faithful to bring it to pass. We continue to pray for a building. We are scouring the countryside looking for something that would be suitable to meet the needs. Real estate is so expensive in our area. We have looked into some church facilities that are available in our town, both sites are out of our price range. We know God can supply the need so we continue to pray and work. If the Lord wants us to have it, He'll make a way for it to happen. The house that we are renting now is fine for a congregation our size; however, future development will require a larger building with a parking lot.

We have had a few new visitors come in the past couple of months. Jerry and his friend, Antoinette, came to us. They both have been involved in drugs. Antoinette responded to the gospel and made a profession of faith. Unfortunately, her past has caught up to her. She is now in jail. Jerry is saved but has gotten mixed up in religion and like many people in our day; he is very confused about what is right and wrong. He has been spending time with the Mormons, the Baptists, and the charismatics. We've tried to be a help and a blessing to him. He'd been spending two out of the three weekly services with us and spending less time with the other groups. We thought he had turned the corner. Now he's disappeared. He's been clean from heroine and meth for five years. Our prayer is that he'll get back in church and get in all the way. Please pray for them. This past week we had a visit from a lady named Lisa. She was passing through on her way to Colorado. She has a son who lives in ABQ. She seemed to enjoy the Sunday School and preaching services and was very friendly. She claims to know the Lord and we trust that she does. We pray for her return.

Our contacts tell us that there might be an opportunity for UG to get started. I am putting a kit together that will be invaluable to get off to a running start. Please, pray for the Lord to start the fire and keep it fueled as it spreads to surrounding areas. We're begging God to get things moving forward. We need the Lord to open doors for us if He wants this to succeed. We need His help and we need it now. We will report more in the future as things develop.

Thank you so much for your prayers and financial support of the ministry that the Lord has called us to do. We praise the Lord for you and your faithfulness to stand beside us as we labor for the souls of men.
