## MISSIONARIES TO WEST AFRICA

Greetings in the name of the Lord,

August 2024

Thank you for your prayers and support for our ministry here in Ghana. Deborah and the boys are doing fine. There has been malaria and other things here and there, but overall, we are all healthy. Joseph is now 17, taller than me, and going to enter into his senior year of high school soon. Joshua is also taller than me now and is doing better in school. Jeremiah hopefully will stay short with dad, ha ha. Deborah is busy with teaching some neighbor kids English and visiting some neighbor ladies. Our next-door neighbor is a widow, and Deborah goes over daily to talk and check on her.

The church has been struggling as our people are mostly late teens entering into the workforce, and jobs have become more important, and faithfulness has gone down some. The world has taken some of our kids away from church as well. One of our boys, Prosper, has stepped up to help me translate on Tuesday nights for our Wednesday morning radio broadcast which is recorded. He has also been my faithful witnessing partner on Saturday mornings along with Joseph. Jennifer, his sister, is translating for Deborah and Tonya Kenney on our Saturday morning Bible club. Joshua helps with the singing for that. We have had a few visitors; they are French speaking women that sit beside Deborah in the service, and she translates for them.

Pray for our radio ministry on Friday night and Wednesday morning. Many listen to the programs but because of social pressures will not come to our church. We have several that listen faithfully to the program that has a wide area which can go about an hour and a half in every direction. Pray that God would open the hearts of our people that they would get saved and come to be discipled. Many members of other area churches listen as well.


Pray for our land situation; it doesn't look good. I bought land that has been tied in court, but it appears I was cheated. I just need direction on this. Pray for a young man named Amouse; he goes to the radio with me every Friday night but won't come to church. Pray for Ange, a woman Deborah is witnessing to, and for other ladies around us that they will get saved. Paqusi sells lottery tickets, and others in and out of the village I have befriended but still they won't come. Sadic is a Muslim man that I have befriended; pray God will open up a way to really get him the gospel. DJ Cash, Ken and the others at the radio station need to be saved.


Pray that God would open some doors here; it is hard to know how to go forward. Many don't want to come because they have their denominational ties, cultural preferences, and love for fleshly worship. The charismatic movement has helped more people find hell than any other force in our country. Pray for God to open the hearts and eyes of our people that they might be saved.
