Guyana This month, we led a group of fourteen on a mission trip to Guyana, South America. First, we visited Missionary Robert Cepec at New Life Baptist Church near Guyana's capital city. We had a great time sightseeing, stamping tracts, soul winning in that scheme (neighborhood), singing, preaching, and doing our best to encourage the young believers there. Next, we took a few small bush planes into the northwest jungle of Guyana to a village called Port Kaituma. This was actually my tenth trip into Port Kaituma and at one point, I lived there for over three months. So for me, this trip was a little like coming home. Our team did a great job helping with a VBS there at Lighthouse Baptist Church. We had nearly three hundred children in attendance! We saw a few understanding children place their faith in Christ during the week and on Sunday, we had a great opportunity to preach the gospel to many lost parents who came! This was the very first mission trip for most of our team and it was such a joy to watch the Lord put a burden on their hearts for the need of the gospel around the world.

Looking Ahead I must be very open and transparent with you. We really do not know what the future holds for our family. I am not quite sure how to explain it, but we do feel like the Lord is going to be moving us on to a new mission field in the future and we need the Lord to give us clear direction and wisdom as we seek His will. I have officially been asked to be the pastor of Lighthouse Baptist Church in Port Kaituma, Guyana. The work was started by Missionary Dean Runyon and God has used him in a mighty way to build the church and property to what it is today. But now his health will not allow him to continue, leaving these people without a pastor. I am trying to be honest with you so that you know how to pray for us! **1 Thessalonians 5:25**
