Dear Praying Friends,

July 2024 Update

The month of July has been different for us. In the middle of June we received word that Robin's dad had been taken to the hospital with what we thought were heart problems. After much testing was done, they found he had a 10 cm hernia that was causing some major problems with pain and pressure throughout his chest, coughing and also difficulty eating. He has also been dealing with several other health issues at the same time. It was

determined that he would need surgery to repair the hernia after some more tests. Robin's sister lives nearby, but she had some travel coming up, so we felt that Robin needed to fly in and stay with him during the time she was gone and plan to stay with him after his surgery. She stayed with him for about 10 days, during which time the remaining testing was done, however, the earliest they could schedule his surgery was August 8th. Once her sister was back home and nearby, she was able to take some time and visit with our kids and grandkids, as well as help at our church's annual Teen Turnout. The Lord blessed that meeting with over 400 people



attending and 2 precious souls saved! Lord willing, she will be flying back to Honduras

August 20<sup>th</sup>.









I have continued to work here, in addition to the usual work and mechanical repairs, preaching in our church services, as well as the Spanish mission church, which has continued to have good attendance. Our first Sunday night at the Spanish mission, we gave out New Testaments, telling them if they brought them back each week and got a mark in the front, on the 5<sup>th</sup> week, they would receive a Spanish whole Bible. Praise the Lord, on Sunday, July 21st, we were

able to give out 6 Spanish whole Bibles! We've been preaching on salvation and pray the Holy Spirit will give a clear understanding of the Gospel to those that are hearing it.

I have also been preparing for an upcoming session of Bible classes in September, teaching thru the minor prophets. These will be evening classes for our student, Levis, and open to anyone who would like to attend. It takes more time for preparation since I am teaching and preparing handouts in Miskito.

This last week of July I have been getting things ready for another Bible Revival with the big tent. That meeting began on August 1<sup>st</sup> and goes thru August 4<sup>th</sup>. Robin worked up a menu and grocery list to provide food for 15 people that Bro Andy brought from the mission church in Puerto Lempira to help with this revival. Some of these folks do not have a clear testimony of salvation, so we are praying the Lord will work in their hearts as well as others that will receive the written and preached Word of God during this revival.





I am also tentatively planning a trip upriver the second week of August, so please remember that in prayer, as well as Robin's dad's upcoming surgery and Robin's travel back to Honduras. We sure do appreciate your faithful prayers on our behalf. We couldn't do what we do without your support and the Lord's help.
