It seems like the challenges are overwhelming at times, but God is also growing us in ways we never would have imagined. He has brought many people into our lives lately to encourage us. We have decided it is necessary for us to take a medical furlough until next May in order to take care of our family. We are now three weeks into the transition back, and we have been very busy working on getting our family settled. The transition to furlough is often as challenging as the transition to the field in many ways.

God has opened the doors for us to have a place to stay near our home church and enroll the children in the Christian school, which is an immense blessing.



Last week we took Ashlyn to Pensacola Christian College in Florida. She is now settled in at college and enjoying the beginning of a new chapter in her life. She will be working toward a degree in youth ministry and

counseling. It is a great blessing to see all that the Lord is doing in her life.

The other kids are now enjoying their new experience at school, although it has been a big adjustment for them. There have been some challenges and some discouragement, but God has given us the grace to work through it with them and with the help of the great people on staff at the school.

The last month has been a whirlwind of activity during a time in which we were already feeling depleted physically and emotionally, but through your prayers and encouragement God has helped us through. As the Lord permits, we will be traveling to visit some of our supporting churches and also to raise more financial and prayer support.

Over the summer God h as continued blessing the ministry in Quebec. We were finally able to start our parking lot project. The first phase of excavation and base preparation is now complete! We now



have a compacted gravel surface that is solid and level. This is already a great improvement and is usable as-is until we are able to install the curbs and asphalt. If you are interested in helping with this project, we still need to raise about \$18,000 to complete the second phase.

We saw several new visitors come to the church over the summer, and our annual garage sale gave us several opportunities to make connections and share the gospel.

During June and July we began a Bible institute course on the inductive Bible study method. It has been a great help to our group of men that teach and preach in the church. Please pray for them as they work together to lead the church in our absence.

We have been praying and searching for a missionary couple that could fill-in for us and especially continue the children's ministry, but we have no-one as of yet. Please help us pray for this need specifically and for more laborers in general for this needy province.

It has been 10 years now since we first moved to Quebec, and the need is greater than ever. Thank you all for your continued support and prayers!
