Last month I had the privilege of visiting our missionaries, Robert and Sara Stover in Tacna, Peru. Since my last visit there, they have made tremendous progress. Souls have been saved, the church has grown, and they have been able to purchase land next door to begin building Sunday School rooms. Brother Stover has a good group of men in his church that help him with all the aspects of the ministry. He also has a tremendous support group of national pastors, whose hearts the Lord has knit together. There are five Baptist churches who help one another with building programs, special meetings and prayer. While I was there, all the churches gathered for a day of games and fellowship, and it was a blessing to see the love they have for one another.

Robert and Sara are not only doing a tremendous job in their ministry, but they are also doing a great work with their eight kids. Their oldest is seventeen, and their youngest was born this past June. One thing that was very noticeable to me was that their kids are 100% plugged into the ministry, and they have a strong connection with the young and old of the church.

Pray for the people of Tacna. It has a population of 342,000 people, and according to what our Lord said, the majority are on the road that leads to destruction. Pray to the Lord of the harvest, that He would send other families, like the Stovers, to Tacna and to the other needy fields of the world.
