Dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings from Haiti. Thanksgiving will soon be here, and we have so much to be thankful for. Daily we experience God's grace, His mercies, His protection, and His provisions each day. God is good to us!

The kids have been in school now since the second week of October. This year safety and security issues caused us to put them all in the same school down on the mountain ridge below us, called Dorilas (Boletan - "by the lake).

The little girls love it, and the 6 of them have done so well with their 2+ mile hike each morning down the mountain. I'm the one they find in the corner napping. Maybe there is no hiking down a mountain, but the 4:30-5:00 wake up call to get all 21 out the door and there to start school by 8 is the downfall! Ha! Sure is a challenge getting all their ribbons just right on 11 heads, but I love it and thank the Lord for each of them. Please pray for them.

Gilbert, Sarah, Miriam, Julianne and Missy are in high school along with Tamar and Lourdie who are in grade school. Of course, Tamar and Lourdie and baby Steve belong to Fritzner and Rolanne. They have taken in my 5 so they can attend school.

Gilbert contacted me last night about the demonstrations yesterday in the village. School was let out and none today. It's very hard for the students. I wonder about our schools up here. It has become almost impossible to find teachers for up here back in the mountains. So many have left under the "Biden Plan," but we do what we can and are thankful for those that are willing. The Lord will bless them.

Schools are very, very expensive for the families here in Haiti. Then there is also the expense of uniforms, books, valises, and all that go with it. These families work very hard for their child's education.

Rolanne contacted me, and we are going to help Moise's sister Roland with some of her school expenses. I'm thrilled we can do it. Through others, God provided that money.

I am so thankful for our little church. Sure look forward to our services each week. Pastor DeMil faithfully comes each Sunday. I marvel at how he can pass on the road when there is so much danger right now. Only God brings him through that gate!

TiPlime is now in his house. Many thanks to those who helped make it possible. No one should ever have to live like that. Such a dear elderly man. Each Sunday he gives a testimony. In September, his brother Bouki was killed, and now he is all alone. We invite him to dinner every so often so; of course, that is included in his testimony! Bless his heart. Please keep him in your prayers.

We have a new family. Gito and Mme Gito. Gito accepted Christ as his Savior in September, and the next Sunday he came with his wife and sister. What a blessing!

We are going to have a marriage in December. Tilo and Roslyn. So glad for them. This month we are hoping to knock out one wall and make the church longer. It will be so nice. Please pray we can find the cement, paint, and all the materials we need. Everything comes from Port au Prince. I can just feel it in my heart Volbin has some stored somewhere. Amen! Ha!

Haiti is not the Haiti I know and love. It has been very hard seeing a country and its people suffering so. Oh my, how the people need our prayers! Right now, it is very hard for the merchants to buy their commerce; so supplies are very hard to find and expensive. Fritzner, Rolanne and Jeso have been a great help and blessing to us. They do our shopping, and Jeso delivers it. Tison is our bread man. He delivers every Tuesday on his way to sell in the street markets behind us. Please pray for their safety.

We are so thankful for each one who lifts us up in prayer. Your prayers are so very much needed, and I know in my heart there are those praying for us. God gives me a special peace.

We are equally thankful for each faithful support and the special gifts. It lets me know that there are those who care and love us. Your prayers and financial support greatly aid the ministry and encourage our hearts.
