In June, we held our reFresh week. This was previously known as our Orientation week. We were blessed to host a record number of missionary families. The Lord met with us during the class times, the evening services, and the fellowship time. We pray that the missionary families that attended left feeling refreshed and eager to continue on in the calling that God has placed upon their lives.

As we host events like reFresh week and our Reach the World Youth Conference, it brings to light a great need for more space. We mentioned in our last letter that we had some exciting news to share with you, and we want to do just that. We would like to tell you about an exciting project the Lord has led us to move forward with here at our International Headquarters in Hoschton, Georgia.



Macedonia World Baptist Missions has been assisting local churches in getting their missionaries to the field since 1967. This partnership is the reason we endeavor each week to use the tools God has given us to meet the needs of our missionaries and to provide the support their sending churches and pastors need and, in fact, must have to carry on the work of the Lord.

As Macedonia's ministry has grown, so has the need for expanding our meeting and training facilities. Currently, we are hosting the Reach the World Youth Conference annually with over 200 people coming to our campus to learn about opportunities for missionary service around the world. We have also experienced cramped quarters during our training classes and meetings for our new missionary candidates. In the past, we have rented temporary shelter

in order to help meet this need; however, that has become not only expensive but increasingly impractical as well.

As a result of this, our Executive Board has decided unanimously to erect a covered pavilion to service these as well as other functions. The pavilion will be located next door to our existing Training Center and will be built with the future in mind. If the need continues to grow, the pavilion can be converted into an enclosed structure.
