While on my last trip in Honduras some national pastors came down from further north in Honduras to get some Gospel tracts.

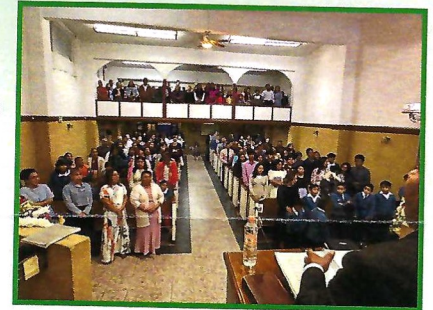


These are some of the one million three hundred thousand you helped us print and ship to Honduras. These pastors were thrilled to receive several boxes of these.
