We were able to get Jesse's paperwork done much quicker than we anticipated. First, he had to get a PNG birth certificate, then we could apply for his US birth certificate and passport. The whole process took us around 7 weeks. Things move slow in Papua New Guinea, so we appreciate any victory we get when it comes to getting paperwork done. God is good to the Wilsons!

Ministry

We are slowly making progress on getting things ready for the ministry on the islands. I have been traveling back and forth between Port Moresby, Alotau, and Normanby Island, handling containers and building projects. We made mention in our last prayer letter how a church in Australia blessed us with a container full of materials for our house. What a blessing! We have since shipped everything to Alotau. We are now working on shifting these materials to the island with cargo boats (Bible College never had any classes on logistics.) We were able to start construction on the house, and we are looking forward to the day when we can finally be settled on the island and get the ministry going. Another container arrived recently for us. This one was sent from Ridgeview Baptist Church in Maryville, Tennessee. This container contained thousands of Bibles, tracts, and all of the literature needed for the Bible School. The Lord just keeps heaping the blessings!

Recently, we were able to visit with our first church-plant, New Home Baptist Church. We were overwhelmed with joy to see the church still going strong and bearing much fruit. Pastor Amos and his family are doing well, and we are thankful for their faithfulness to the Lord. The Gospel works!
