

## **Typhoon Kristine**

As the typhoon season rages here, "Kristine" was the most devastating with impacts across 17 regions. Approximately 7.1 million people were affected causing widespread displacement with 935,114 individuals residing either in evacuation centers or taking shelter outside of them with their relatives or friends. Several of those are our own missionaries and pastors. One in particular is Pastor Jim Dolom in Oas, Albay with his 6-month old pregnant wife and 5 year old daughter. We have to flew them out immediately back with us as his wife is getting sick until the waters subside and we can travel together by land back to bring relief goods

and help our brethren in that region. Please do pray and we would ask some help to raise \$25 per family food pack for 250 church-families in that region.

praying, and preparing to host about 200 local pastors and missionaries nationwide to be with us on Nov. 21-22 and some until Nov 24 for our




church anniversary. Pray that they will be accommodated, fed, and helped spiritually through the preachings and
