We were able to have meals and time of fellowship before heading out to organize things for the wedding. We hope to be able to follow through with plans to have a group of four with us from Mexico for a week in February. Valledupar has a new botanic desert garden park near the Church where we plan to have a bit of very much needed evangelistic activities.

Without getting into much detail, violence and crime continue to increase. Kidnappings and extortions also.
