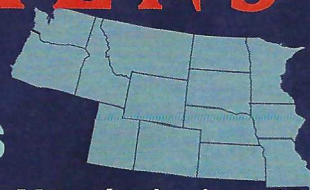

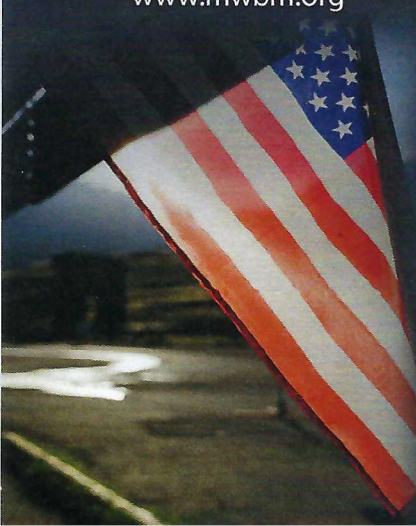

Dear Co-Labourers,

As we enter a new year, I am thanking God for what He has done in the past year. As I have been reading the book of Malachi, verse 3:1a says, "Behold, I will send my messenger." God is sending families around the world to preach His message. If we read down in Malachi 3:6a, it says "For I am the LORD, I change not." I am glad we have a calling to reach the world with the message that Jesus saves lost sinners.

I have been talking to the church planters in the Northwest. The Devil is fighting, but God is using His Word to touch hearts and change lives. This is a hard time for them with the colder weather and snow. However, God's work is going on. Please keep these families in your prayers.

Sister Hutchens and I are working on the plans for our Northwestern Orientation School taking place in July this year. It takes a lot of planning and work. We are looking forward to having 13-14 families plus all the helpers there. We not only have classes for the adults but we also have a VBS for their kids. We are praying for 40 to 50 kids. We have classes in the daytime and preaching services at night. Please help us pray for this time.

Now, for an update on my health issues: after the heart attack, I had to go back into the hospital over night due to chest pains and high blood pressure. I finally had to temporarily stop the cardio rehab; and on January 6th, I had another heart cath done because of the continuing chest pain and high blood pressure. That test determined that I did not need another stint at this time, and my medicines will be tweaked to bring down the blood pressure. I will be starting cardio rehab again on January 13th.

For the update on Sister Hutchens health issues: she had to go back to the ER again and was admitted again for 4 days. Her liver enzymes continue to be elevated, and she has episodes of pain and nausea. These episodes are being treated with pain meds to prevent returns to the ER. She had extensive blood tests while in the hospital which eliminated some possible causes of her problem. She has a liver biopsy scheduled on January 16th and an endoscopy scheduled on January 22nd. They are trying to figure out what is irritating her liver to cause the pain and nausea episodes and elevated liver enzymes. Please pray for answers and a treatment plan.
