Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,

Thank you so much for your faithful prayers for our family and ministry. It's hard to believe that another year has passed, but we are incredibly thankful for how God worked in 2024. We are looking ahead with excitement and anticipation at all God will do in 2025!

In our last prayer letter we told you about the trip that Logan and I would be taking to Honduras. We are so thankful to share that the trip was a success. It was quite an adventure, but God did a tremendous work in both the Hondurans and the young men that went on the trip with us. For three of the young men, it was their first time out of the USA. We traveled by plane from Atlanta to San Pedro Sula, a fairly large city in Honduras, then traveled by taxi van for 4 hours to a town called La Ceiba. We spent the night there and flew out the next morning on a 16 passenger plane to Puerto Lempira, where we landed on a dirt airstrip. Our plan was to travel by Jeep to the remote village of Auka, but the weather had a different plan. Tropical Storm Sara made landfall in Honduras, right on top of us. So, for the next 2 days, we camped out in one of the primitive national church buildings, in our hammocks. Once the storm passed, we made our way to Auka. Bro. Trask's Jeep broke down and our only transport was by 4-wheeler and wooden trailer. It was not a comfortable ride, but we made it, 6 hours later. We set up a large tent in the village and started holding services. Over 200 people came each night and we were able to hand out over 450 Bibles to people that have never had a copy of God's Word in their language. What a tremendous privilege! We endured sun burn and innumerable bug bites, but all of us would go again in a heartbeat. To see the great need in remote Honduras and the burden of the missionary that is there laboring, gave each of us a heart for that place and a burden to see them reached with the Gospel. I am incredibly thankful to have had the privilege to expose these young men to the mission field. Thank you for praying for the team and the trip.
