Everyone has stepped up and taken care of all the different ministries, so that when we have had guest preachers, they have had very little to do in the services besides preaching. One of our most faithful men has taken the full responsibility of running the church, another has been running the evangelism programs, another has been leading the choir, and many more have taken further responsibilities upon themselves.

In mid-February, they held Friends and Family Day where we saw an attendance of around one hundred and saw two people saved. One of which was a first-time visitor and the other is a man I have been working with for some time, since his wife got saved and baptized last year. We have also seen some professions of faith in the churches where I have been preaching at in the US.
