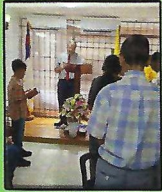

When we first arrived here in 2015, things were quite a bit better as the years of violence and bloodshed had lessened. In the last few months and years, that has taken a turn in the wrong direction as we have seen less stability. In spite of all that, one of our greatest challenges has been due to my health situation and the need to be closer to the health specialists we need to receive treatment and adequate health care.

The group from Mexico that planned to be with us in February arrived in the beginning of March. They are working very hard, and we have been busy. Please continue to help us pray for laborers in the field. We continue to take the gospel to the lost and are trusting in the Lord for His direction and care. Also, please pray as we seek the Lord's help in finding a more suitable location for the Church.

Helping Esteban to Prepare

Esteban, like lots of Colombians who prepare for the ministry, is busy working different jobs to provide for the needs of his family. He is in Tunja now. We have made use of the Internet to have virtual classes for using the Institute materials. Esteban and a group from his family are now learning, and we trust the Lord to help us to prepare others as He works to call them.

Personal Needs

Martha has had good results from the oral surgery but is still awaiting the opportunity in the future to be in Bogota to finish it. Timothy has his ID (cedula) awaiting him to pick it up when he goes back to Bogota as well. I have been seen by the endocrinologist, the urologist, the neurologist who specializes in treating Parkinson's, and the physical medicine doctor. I also saw the surgeon who did my cancer surgeries. He told me that what I have is residual from cancer surgeries, it is very small and is growing very slowly. He has decided to study it for a while.

We are truly blessed and thank the Lord for the wonderful saints of God that He has faithfully praying and giving for us to minister here. You are all very special people to us. We love you.
