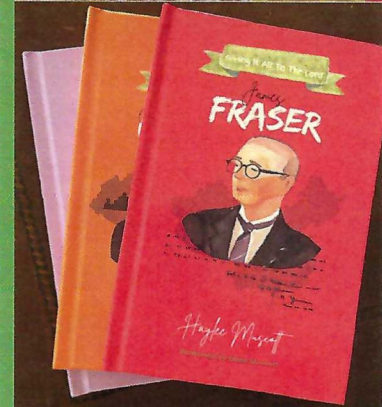
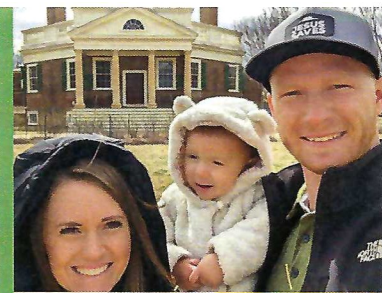
Dearest Church Family, February 2025
