Well, we're thankful to come back to you for another report of what God has been doing here in the ministry. We praise the Lord for your consistent support financially and through prayers. God has been faithful and is continually doing a work through us and in us.

The work here at Harvest Baptist Church is continuing, and we are seeing many blessings. Since our last prayer letter, we have seen people saved as well as projects started and completed. Our auditorium is finished, and the remodel is completed in that area of the building. Right now, we are working on the dining hall/gym as well as other portions of the basement. We will be restarting our van ministry this June. The addictions ministry is reaching people on a weekly basis, as well as our Spanish department. Continue to pray for all the workers that dedicate their time and life throughout every week to reach Santa Fe, New Mexico.

The report for "His Harvest Ministries" which is our church planting arm here at Harvest Baptist Church is continually encouraging. Right now, we have these towns with church plants that are listed below coming out of Harvest Baptist Church.

1. Church plant in Causes Grandes, Chihuahua, Mexico
2. Church plant in Nueva Casas Grandes, Chihuahua, Mexico.
3. Church plant in El Willie, Chihuahua, Mexico. These three are being led by Jose Valenzuela, one of our national missionaries who is a member of Harvest Baptist Church.
4. Church plant in Santa Isabel, Chihuahua, Mexico
5. Church plant in Samalopan, Chihuahua, Mexico. These two are being led by Eduardo Orozco, another national missionary who is a member of Harvest Baptist Church.
6. Church plant in Antonito, Colorado
7. Church plant in Las Vegas, New Mexico. These two are being led by myself. The Las Vegas Church plant has an assistant pastor. His name is Wayne Matheson, and he's working as my assistant at this time. He had joined Harvest Baptist Church and will become the soul senior pastor of the Las Vegas Church plant on the constituting Sunday of June 1, 2025. On this day, he and all those who are proper candidates will become the charter members of this brand new Independent Baptist Church. Pray for the work during this transition period.
8. Church plant in Janos, Chihuahua, Mexico
9. Church plant in Monte Verde, Chihuahua, Mexico. These two church plants are being led by Charlie Powell, our American missionary who is a member of Harvest Baptist Church. Praise the Lord, Brother Powell was able to purchase and remodel a church building and parsonage in Janos. Pray for the plant in Monte Verde as it grows from an evangelistic point to a church plant status and ultimately an indigenous church. This month will be the second service that they will have there in that pueblo.
10. Church plant in Telatinango, Zacatecas, Mexico will begin in the month of May. This work will be led by Carlos Monterubio, who will be joining Harvest Baptist Church this spring as our next national church planter.

If you are interested in getting behind any of these men individually, they are all being sent out of Harvest Baptist Church and are extremely worthy of financial support.

Last week, myself and a group of men from our church delivered 750,000 gospel tracts and 2000 Spanish Bibles to approximately 40 - 50 Independent Baptist pastors in the Baja of California. This is the state on the extreme western side of Mexico. They are somewhat isolated from the rest of the country, and many of them said it had been years since they received tracts and Bibles in a shipment of this fashion. We plan to carry a shipment at least annually with double or more of this amount for these pastors. We have already heard reports of God giving the increase as the gospel is distributed. Pray for this endeavor as it grows.

Pray for my family. All the kids are growing and maturing. Some have established entrepreneurial endeavors through our farm. The two oldest are partnering in shed building endeavors as well as plans for a landscaping business this spring. By the end of this month, my two oldest as well as my wife and I will be visiting missionaries Gene and Robin Trask in Honduras for a mission strip. Pray for safety and traveling mercies. We also desire for God to work in the hearts of our boys and through us so that we might be a blessing on this trip. Keep us in your prayers and God bless you.
