On August 25th we will host a "Super Saturday" all day youth activity with a sister church. Please pray that the Lord would use this activity to draw more young people to the Lord.

In the midst of all these events, we have also continued work on the new church. The building inspection passed, and we are waiting on the electric company to hook up the permanent electricity. After that, we can begin building the platform and several interior walls. We hope to begin services there in September on the first floor while work continues on the second floor auditorium. Praise the Lord we are down to needing about \$50,000 to finish the church. God has worked in miraculous ways and many of you have been a part of that miracle. We and the Taiwan Church are very grateful. In the land of ornate Buddhist temples, it is a testimony to our God to see this beautiful new building as a lighthouse in our community. Thank you for continuing to pray for us and being a vital part of what the Lord is doing here.
